



Your patient, Rickey Thompson, was admitted to Senior Care of Marion on 2/9/2021. A customized rehabilitation program was implemented to address functional deficits related to the diagnosis of muscle weakness, difficulty with gait.

After successfully completing the therapy program at Senior Care of Marion, Rickey Thompson was discharged to long-term care.

The patient's rehabilitation treatment program consisted of the following skilled interventions:

**OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY:** 5x/week x 4 weeks  
**PHYSICAL THERAPY:** 5x/week x 6 weeks  
**SPEECH THERAPY:** 0x/week x 0 weeks

#### Discharge Status:

Rickey Thompson was discharged from Senior Care of Marion on 4/1/2021.

#### Additional Notes:

Mr. Thompson came to our facility after being hospitalized with generalized weakness, dehydration, and difficulty ambulation. He was overall deconditioned in all areas. Upon admission he was non-ambulatory, unable to perform ADL's without assistance and required help with bed mobility and transfers. At discharge Mr. Thompson has met all of his goals. He is now able to perform all of his self-care, he is able to transfer in and out of bed with no assistance. He is able to ambulate with a rolling walker for greater than 100ft, but still uses a wheelchair for mobility until his wound heals. His plan is to leave us and go to an Assisted Living Facility.
