

REHABILITATION OUTCOMES SUMMARY

Your patient, Larry Jernigan, was admitted to Senior Care of Marion on 1/18/2021. A customized rehabilitation program was implemented to address functional deficits related to the diagnosis of Pulmonary: Pneumonia COVID, Post Polio Syndrome.

After successfully completing the therapy program at Senior Care of Marion , Larry Jernigan was discharged to home.

The patient's rehabilitation treatment program consisted of the following skilled interventions:

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY: 5x/week x 6 weeks

PHYSICAL THERAPY: 5x/week x 6 weeks

SPEECH THERAPY: 0x/week x 0 weeks

Discharge Status:

Larry Jernigan was discharged from Senior Care of Marion on 2/26/2021.

Additional Notes:

Mr. Jernigan came to Senior Care of Marion after being in the hospital with a diagnosis of COVID-19 and pneumonia. Mr. Jernigan also has post polio syndrome which has affected his L arm and L leg. Upon admission Mr. Jernigan was unable to perform bed mobility without maximum assistance for lying to sitting at the edge of bed. Pt was also unable to stand without assistance at bedside. Pt was unable to ambulate for first week he was here. Mr. Jerningan put forth extreme effort to improve not only his strength, but his endurance by participating in PT and OT 5 times a week for apprxoximately 6 weeks. Upon discharge Mr. Jernigan was able to perform bed mobility with no assistance, transfer himself in and out of bed with no help, and able to perform his personal grooming with no assistance. Mr. Jerningan was able to ambulate using a rolling walker for approximatley 300ft and able to stand to perform tasks for greater than 5-10 mins. He was so happy to be able to go home feeling a sense of security to be able to take care of himself.
