Ms. Crawford was admitted to SCOM on 6/24/2020. She previously had been living independently using her Rollator to ambulate short distances around her home.

Unfortunately, she was admitted to the hospital due to multiple falls as well as left leg venous stasis ulcer. Upon admission to SCOM, she was unable to ambulate due to overall weakness and unsteadiness on her feet as well as severe leg pain.

She was completely dependent for all functional mobility tasks. She was a hard worker and was determined to get better and return home.

Over the course of 11 weeks of rehab she regained her strength and endurance. She was able to achieve all her goals and can walk 100 feet with her Rollator. She is also able to complete all her ADLs independently.
